Feb. 23 6:30 p.m.	MultiKulti Center 1000 N. Milwaukee Ave Chicago	FRONTLINE: Nuclear Aftershocks 55 min., 2012	The controversial FRONTLINE show which aired in January examines the aftereffects of the Fukushima disaster on the future of nuclear power.
March 22 6:30 p.m.	MultiKulti Center 1000 N. Milwaukee Ave Chicago	Into Eternity 78 min, 2010	An examination of nuclear waste disposal from a perspective rarely considered, using the ongoing construction of the Onkolo nuclear waste dump in Finland as the backdrop. Haunting and powerful.

Milwaukee Ave Chicago	The Battle of Chernobyl 90 min, 2006	Perhaps the best documentary about the Chernobyl disaster ever made, shown on the 26 th anniversary of the event. Significant in that it explores the event from a largely Eastern European standpoint.

Milwaukee Ave Chicago	Rokkoshō Rhapsody 119 min., 2006 <i>(NOTE: a voluntary collection for Japanese relief efforts will be taken)</i>	Documents the struggles of local Japanese villagers and fishermen to stop the controversial and insanely costly Rokkasho nuclear reprocessing facility. Pre-Fukushima activism. Artistically beautiful – and heartbreaking.
June 28 6:30 p.m.	TBD	Deep Green: Solutions to Stop Global Warming Now 90 min., 2011	Can the world really do without nuclear power? You bet it can! This documentary examines how to tackle global warming through the de-carbonization of energy – without using nuclear power.
