- **A federal court ruling has forced a moratorium on the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's ability to license new nuclear reactors or renew existing nuclear reactor licenses.**
- **Confidence that a permanent location for the nuclear waste will be found no longer can be used as a generic answer to what will happen with nuclear waste, say the federal courts.**
- **Now the Nuclear Regulatory Commission must say how the waste will impact the environment.**

70,000+ tons of high level radioactive waste and no place to permanently put it. It is not safe and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission wants to keep stockpiling it in our communities for over 100 years.
